It is a story set in the late 1920's about Mexican retired General. Gorostieta and his wife as they watch their country degenerate into a violent civil war when the government enacts a series of anti-clerical laws. Gorostieta is at first hesitant to join the rebels, known as Cristeros, until he begins to see the cost of religious persecution on his countrymen. Though the odds are against him, the general nevertheless transforms a ragtag band of rebels into a formidable fighting force. Many of the Cristeros were Knights of Columbus. In May of

2000 Pope John Paul II Canonized 25 Martyrs from the Cristiada Period, 6 of which were members of the KofC. Run time is 2 hours 25 min. Recommended for Teens and older.
