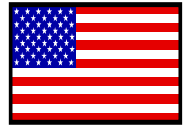

How often have we protested about something that was happening or something we had to do: leaving a job or a place, saying good-bye to someone who is loved, taking up difficult work? Rarely do we see these moments as seeds that God would water and tend until they produced good fruit. He's trustworthy, but tricky. Isaiah's text, "...making (the earth) fertile and fruitful, giving seed to the one who sows and bread to the one who eats... reminds us of how radical **trust** is and how radically **trustworthy** God is. He sends rain on the earth, Isaiah says; it becomes fruit and bread. He sends His Word; it returns to Him as His will accomplished. His Word is Christ. Could His Word also be fruitful in us?
